“The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden, to work it and take care of it.” Genesis 2:15

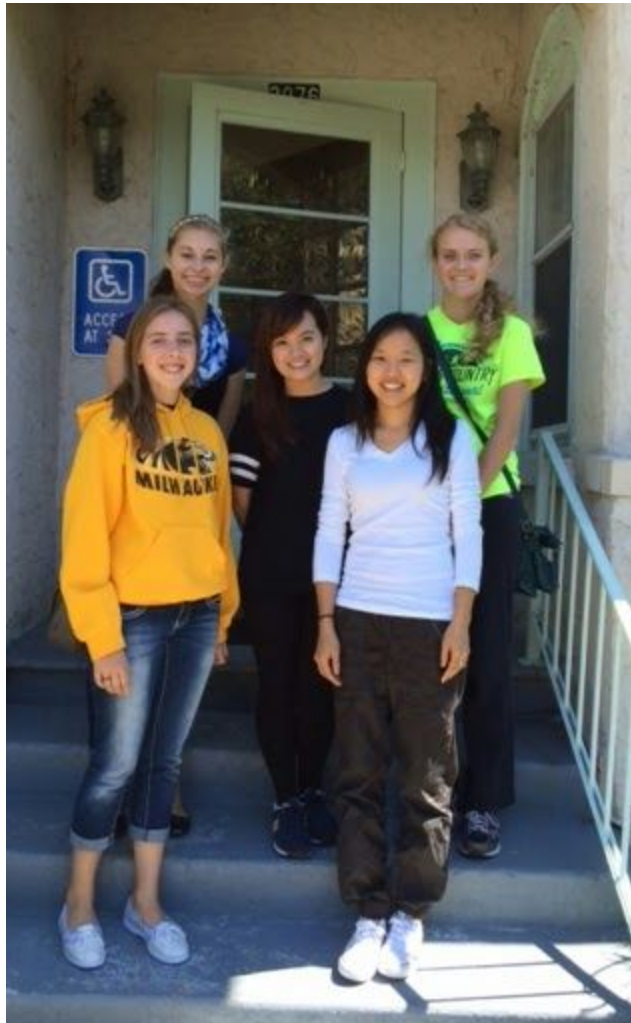

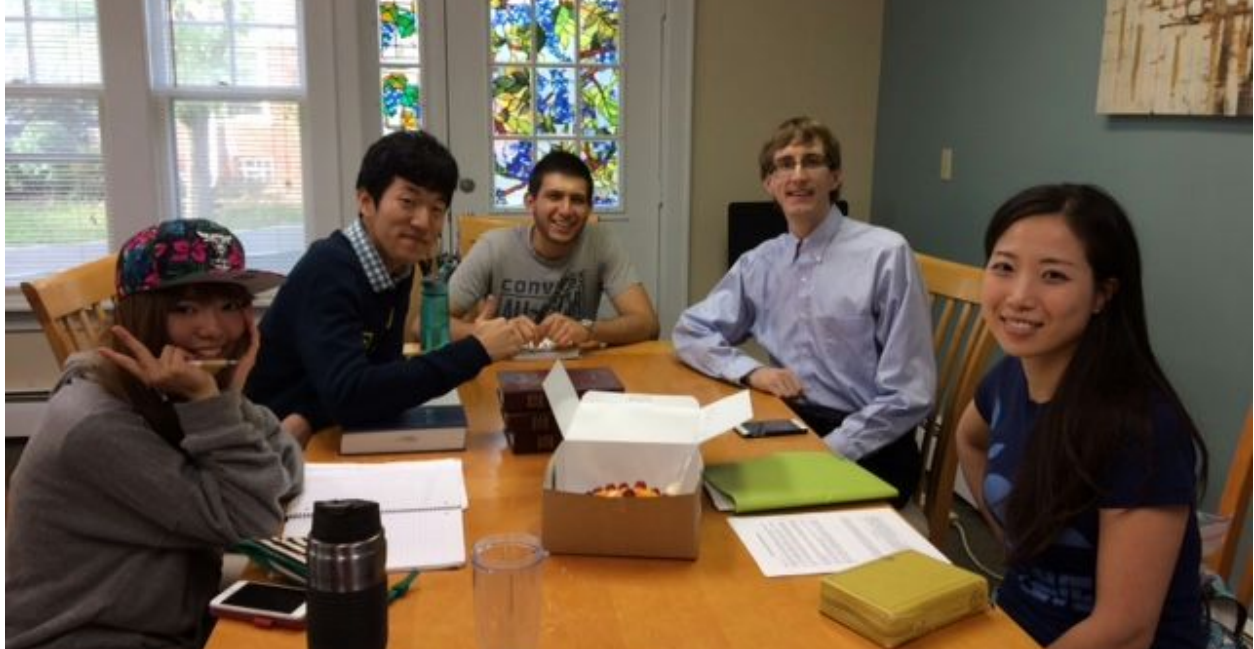
